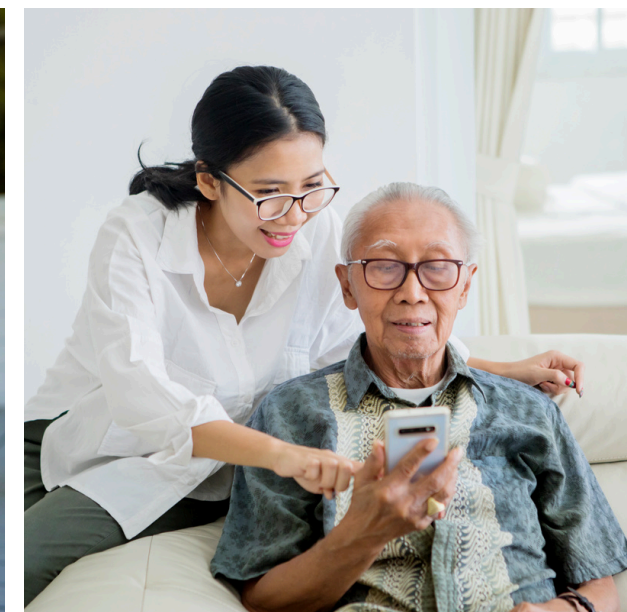

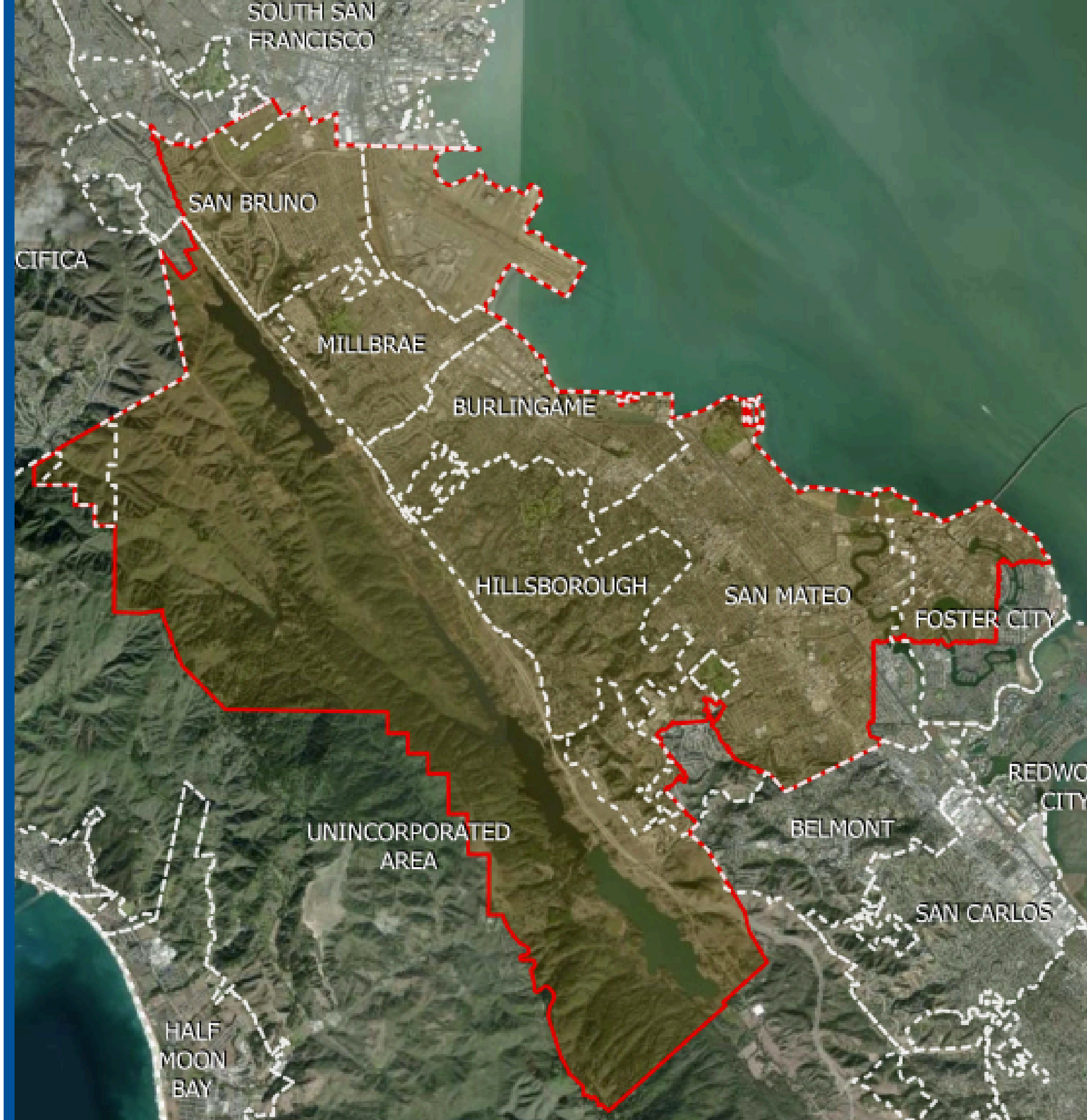

Community Grants Program Overview

- Established in 1986; serves as one of the District's community benefit strategies to address the health needs of its residents.
- The District seeks partnerships with organizations that share our Vision and demonstrate alignment with our Strategic Plan, Focus Areas and Priorities.
- We partner with a diverse network of community organizations in our service area.





Guidelines and Eligibility Criteria



- **Programs and services that fall within the scope of public health and health care as it relates to priority areas.**



- **Grants are made in the range of \$15,000 – \$70,000.**



- **Only one grant request per applicant organization will be considered*****



- **Cannot be used for research projects, fundraising campaigns or events.**



Guidelines and Eligibility Criteria



- **Grants are open to 501(c)(3) non-profit organizations or public agencies serving our residents of San Bruno, Millbrae, Burlingame, Hillsborough, San Mateo, half of Foster City, and/or a small southeast corner of South San Francisco.**



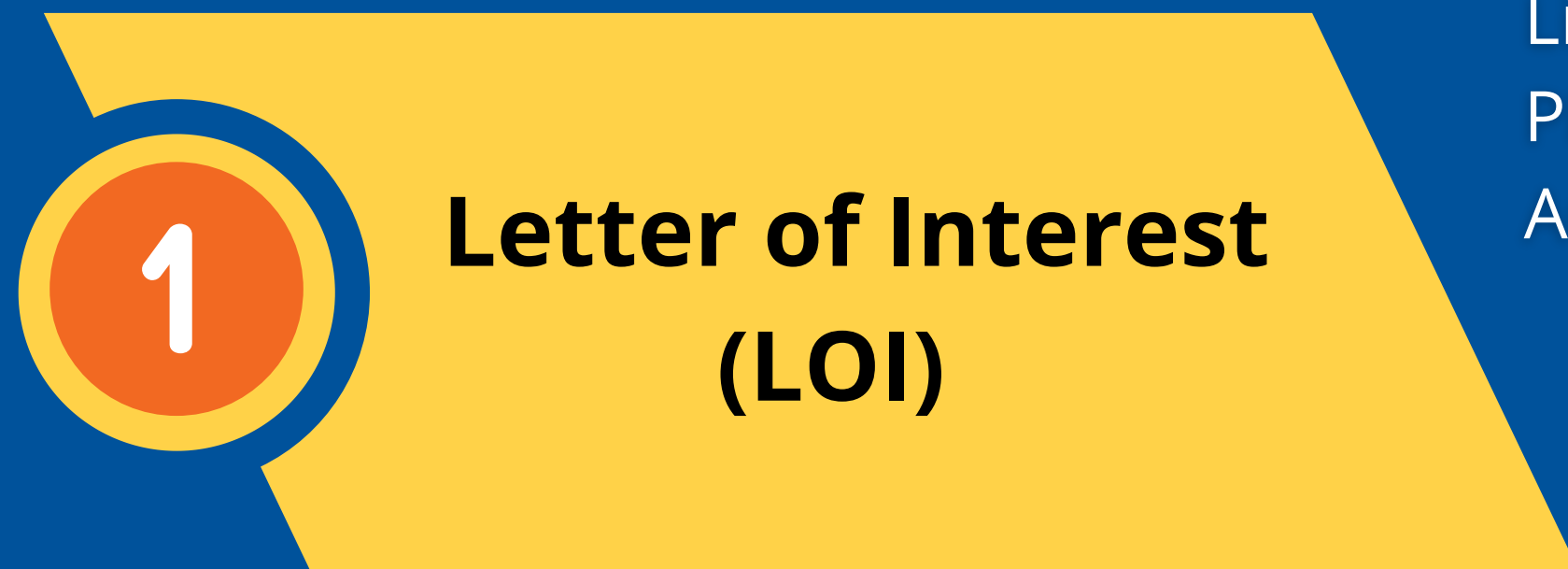

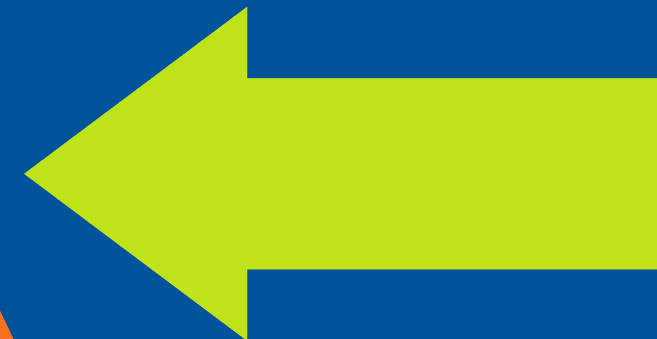
Only one-year grants are available for 2027

Application Process

- PHCD operates a two-step grant process.

A link to the online grants' portal will be provided once an organization is invited to complete a full grant application. (applications will be due October 9th)

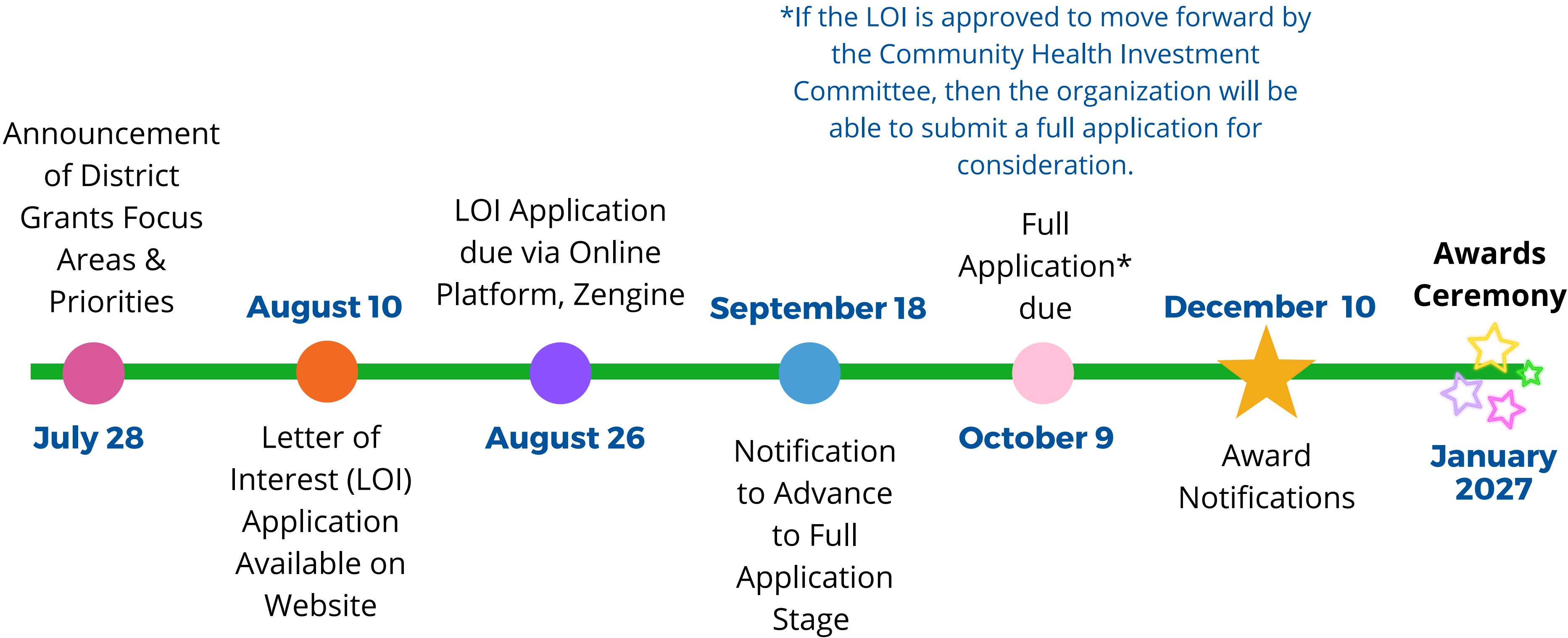
